2.00pm Māori Engagement Framework

To provide Elected Members with an update on the Iwi/Hapū Relationship Framework, including changes made following the March Briefing, and to ensure visibility and opportunity for further input ahead of the framework returning to Council for adoption in June.

3.00pm Housing and Business Development Group Overview and Direction
