7.1 Joint Water Services Delivery Plan

This report sought endorsement of the joint Water Services Delivery Plan (WSDP), ahead of adoption, certification and submission to the Secretary for Local Government, developed in accordance with the Local Government (Water Services Preliminary Arrangements) Act 2024.

That Council delegates authority to the Chief Executive to enter into and sign the Collaboration Agreement with Palmerston North City Council and Rangitikei District Council to progress the joint work programme outlined in the Implementation Plan, noting there will be a full Council workshop first.

That Council notes that there remains the potential that Ruapehu District Council and Whanganui District Council could be willing to partner as shareholders in the Joint WSCCO, but that this is subject to those Councils making formal decisions to endorse that form of Joint WSCCO (involving up to 5 councils), as well as the necessary due diligence and approvals required by the current partner Councils (HDC, PNCC, RDC).
- I. That Council encourages Ruapehu District Council and Whanganui District Council to continue constructive discussions with the [Project Team], and with the Department of Internal Affairs, to determine the pathway that would provide for them to become shareholders in the Joint WSCCO, including clarifying what that would require for the current partner Councils and their Joint WSDP (assuming it is accepted by the Secretary of Local Government on its current terms).
